- Supported the Junior Diabetes Walk-a-thon. Raised and donated over \$7,300 to this project.
- Major project for the year has been the design, purchase and distribution of over 25,000 child safety seat stickers to identify and provide critical child information for emergency response providers.

- Members rang bells for the Salvation Army Christmas fund raising project.

- Over one third of our members delivered Christmas Charities food and toys to needy families.
